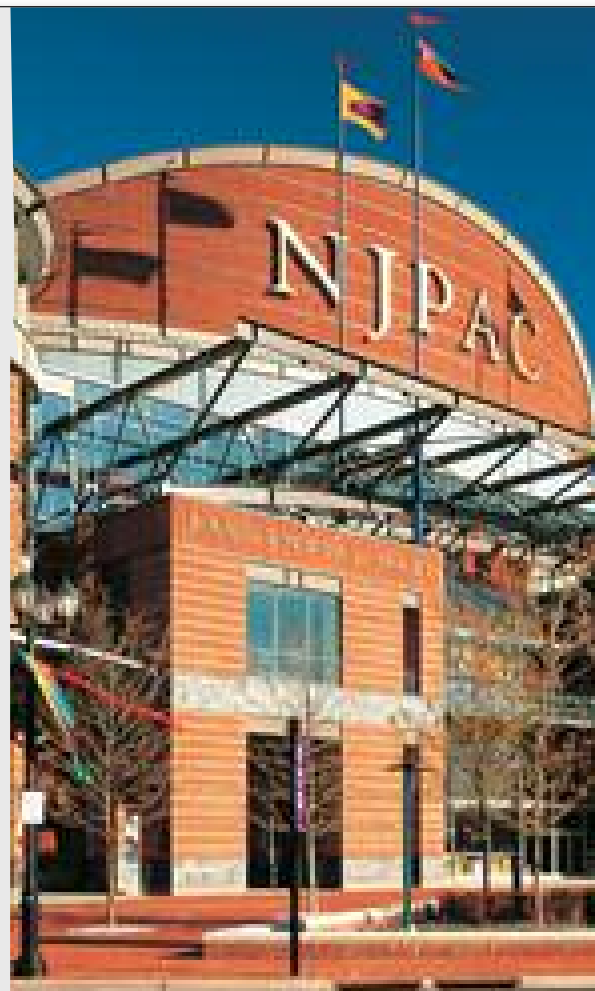
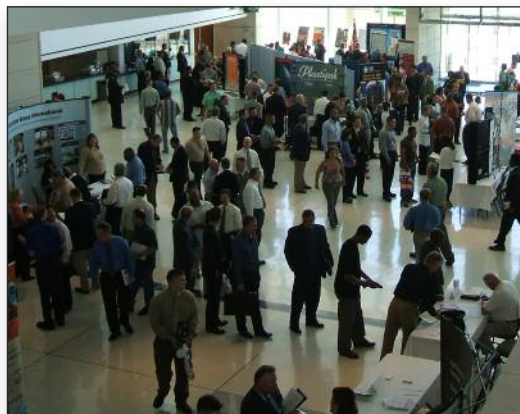

To prepare for the fair:

1. Register as a job seeker at www.recruitmilitary.com
2. Show up at the door with at least a dozen copies of your resume.



Your marching orders to a successful career fair

1. YOU WILL NOT assume that, when a recruiter asks you to e-mail your resume to the company Web site, you are being brushed off. Companies require their recruiters to direct job seekers to their sites (1) to obtain HR information as required by law and (2) so they can direct desirable job seekers to different departments—a good reason for you to network for unlisted open jobs! Asking for a resume to be e-mailed also acts as a test of a job seeker's interest in entering the interview process. **YOU WILL go to the Web site and input your information.**

2. YOU WILL NOT assume that a company's name or primary industry tells you what job openings the firm will be trying to fill at the career fair. For example, a retail drug company may be recruiting for positions in transportation/distribution/warehousing or accounting. **YOU WILL try to talk to everybody.**

3. YOU WILL NOT just tuck the Program Guide in your bag and head for the booths right after you sign in. Take some time to read the ads to see what jobs are open, bearing in mind that companies cannot list all the openings they have. Even if an advertised job is not what you are after, use the Program Guide to learn about the company so you can network into your area of expertise at the company booth. **YOU WILL plan how you are going to use your time effectively.**

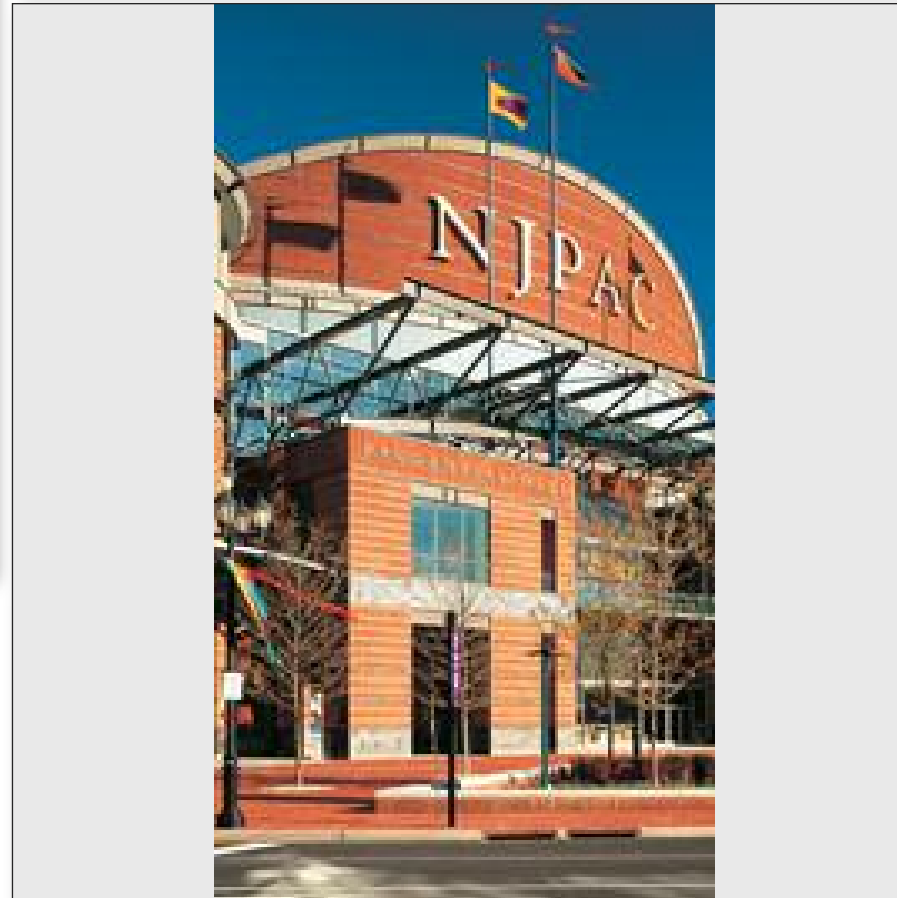
4. YOU WILL NOT stand in a long line for one of your "A list" companies if the recruiters at a "B list" booth don't look busy—even if the event is in its last hour. Take advantage of the opportunity to tell your complete story to the "B" recruiters. But what about the "A list" company? We've had some recruiters stay around to talk to job seekers well past 4:00! **YOU WILL keep track of what's going on.**

Driving directions

FROM THE SOUTH via NJ Turnpike North: Follow the turnpike to Exit 15W (Newark/The Oranges). After toll booth, follow Route 280 West to Exit 15A (Route 21 - Downtown/Arts). At bottom of ramp (traffic light), make a right onto Route 21 South (McCarter Highway). Follow Route 21 South to Center Street, make a right onto Center Street.

Via Garden State Parkway North: Follow the parkway to Exit 145 (Route 280). Follow Route 280 East to Exit 15 (Route 21 - Downtown/Arts). At bottom of ramp (traffic light), make a right onto Route 21 South, (McCarter Highway). Follow Route 21 South to Center Street, make a right onto Center Street.

FROM THE NORTH, NORTHEAST & NEW YORK CITY via NJ Turnpike South: Follow the turnpike to Exit 15W (Newark/The Oranges). After toll booth, follow Route 280 West to Exit 15A (Route 21 - Downtown). Follow signs to Route 21 South (McCarter Highway). Make a right onto Route 21 South (McCarter Highway). Follow Route 21 South to Center Street, make a right onto Center Street.

Via Garden State Parkway South: Follow the parkway to Exit 145. Follow signs to Route 280 East. Follow Route 280 East to Exit 15 (Route 21 - Downtown/Arts). At bottom of ramp (traffic light), make a right onto Route 21 South (McCarter Highway). Follow Route 21 South to Center Street, make a right onto Center Street.

From New York City: From George Washington Bridge or Lincoln Tunnell, follow signs to NJ Turnpike South. Take NJ Turnpike South to Exit 15W. From Holland Tunnel, follow signs to NJ Turnpike North. Take NJ Turnpike North to Exit 15W. Follow directions from Exit 15W above.

FROM THE WEST via Route 280: Follow Route 280 East to Exit 15 (Route 21 South - Downtown/Arts). At bottom of ramp (traffic light), make a right onto Route 21 South (McCarter Highway). Follow Route 21 South to Center Street, make a right onto Center Street.

Via Route 78: Follow Route 78 East to Exit 57 (Newark, Downtown/Arts). Stay to the right and follow signs to Route 21 North (McCarter Highway). You will travel across the viaduct into downtown Newark. Stay in the left three lanes and travel onto Route 21 North (McCarter Highway). Follow Route 21 North to Center Street, make a left onto Center Street. If you miss this turn, continue on Route 21 North to the Lombardy Street jughandle, then make the U-turn back to Route 21 South until you reach Center Street. Make a right onto Center Street.
